This event addresses the conditions for spin-off intentions and activities by female scientists and students at Swiss Universities. And it allows to learn from first measures to promote spin-off creation of female scientists across disciplines and university types.

It is the starting point for a variety of activities in which all Swiss universities can participate. Representatives from gender & diversity, knowledge and technology transfer (KTT), innovation and start-up centers, and further stakeholders are invited to meet and discuss.

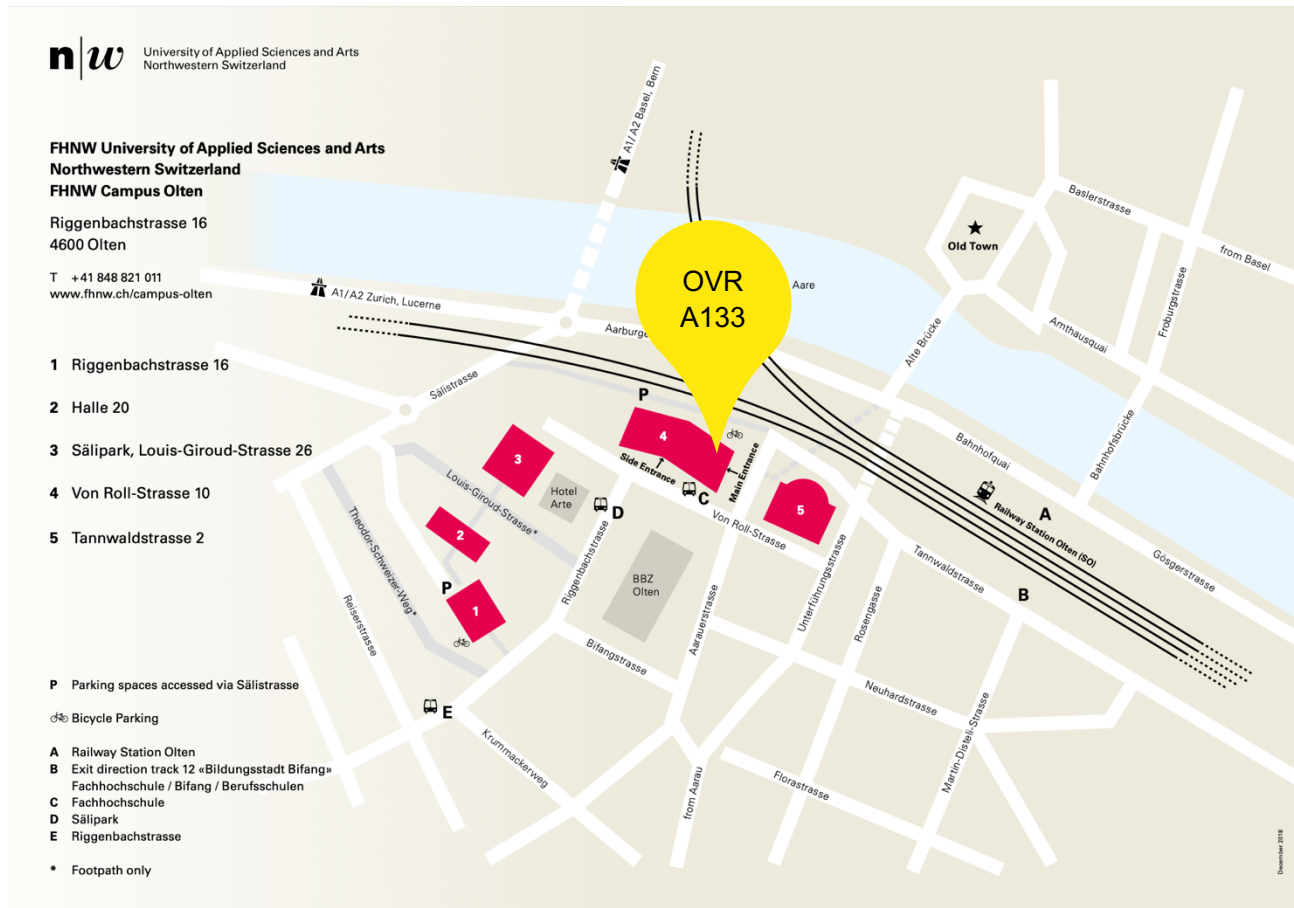
